MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

1. Membership in SPAC is for the calendar year January 1 to December 31.
2. Membership entitles members to shoot indoors on club nights. Club night location, dates and times will be posted on the SPAC website <http://www.sparchery.ca>. Club nights normally start in the fall and continue during the winter.
3. Members are expected to have their memberships cards visible for inspection for the duration of their shooting at the Sherwood Park Archery Lanes during club nights, and at the outdoor range.
4. Eligible members may use the Club's Outdoor Range at anytime during the calendar year for which the membership is purchased, except during scheduled events at the Range. The Outdoor Range is located at Range Road (R.R.) 224 and Township Road (Twp. Rd.) 520. All junior members must be accompanied by an adult at the Outdoor Range. The gate combination for the Outdoor Range is available at the Sherwood Park Archery Lanes desk, or from any of the Club Executive.
5. Registration for the Junior Program is held in late September and includes an additional Junior Program Fee per Junior. Completion of an Emergency Contact form is also required. The Junior Program operates from October through April indoors, and outdoors in May. The program is a weekly, instructor led 90 minute session held on Saturday mornings. Two class time choices are available at registration.
6. Any regular memberships purchased after, or in conjunction with, Junior Program registration in late September, allow the member indoor privileges for the remainder of the year preceding the membership year.
7. Membership in SPAC includes mandatory membership in either ABA or ATAA, or in both if desired. Membership in ABA or ATAA includes mandatory membership in FCA.
8. FCA – Federation of Canadian Archers - National body whose membership includes required insurance (PL&PD) coverage for all SPAC members. Current membership in the FCA is mandatory. Membership allows you to shoot in all FCA sanctioned events. Having an FCA number does not automatically mean you have a current FCA membership. More information is available on the FCA website.
9. ABA – Alberta Bowhunters Association – Provincial body where membership is required for any provincial ABA sanctioned shoots. Also includes ABA newsletter and eligibility for game awards program. More information is available on the ABA website.
10. ATAA – Alberta Target Archers Association – Provincial body where membership is required for any provincial ATAA sanctioned events. Also includes ATAA newsletter. More information is available on the ATAA website.
11. If a membership applicant has membership independently with the ATAA or ABA, and can provide a membership card from one or more of these organizations, as applicable, that will be valid until the end of the current SPAC year, then fees related to those affiliations will be deducted from the cost of SPAC membership.
12. A service fee of \$30 will be charged on all dishonoured cheques (such as NSF), to cover related fees charged to the club as a result of such cheques.
